

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BY AND BETWEEN
THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION
AND
THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made by and between the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation (BWC) and the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of State Fire Marshal (DOC).

I. Purpose

- 1.1 Pursuant to R.C. 121.17, directors of state departments are required to co-operate with each other in the employment of services. BWC and DOC are willing to cooperate for the benefit of their agencies; and
- 1.2 The education of employers and employees with respect to occupational safety standards is incidental to and necessary for the prevention of industrial accidents and diseases in accordance with the main purpose of R.C. 4121.37 and provides a public benefit to the citizens of Ohio;
- 1.2 Therefore, the purpose of this MOU is to memorialize an agreement between DOC and BWC whereby BWC agrees to transfer funds from the BWC safety and hygiene fund to the DOC Firefighter I Training Grant Program by which Ohio first responders shall receive safety training.

II. Authority

- 2.1 This MOU is promulgated under sections 3737.22 and 4121.37 of the Revised Code.

III. Term/Termination

- 3.1 This MOU shall be effective upon full execution and shall expire on the later of June 30, 2015 or upon the final expenditure by DOC of funds encumbered in accordance with this MOU. Either party may suspend or terminate this MOU if the General Assembly fails to appropriate funds in accordance with Section IV. of this MOU or if either party fails to abide by the terms of this agreement.
- 3.2 This MOU may only be modified by mutual written agreement by the parties, signed by duly authorized representatives of each of the parties.

- 3.3 This MOU may be renewed by written agreement of the parties. Such renewal may include additional terms as mutually agreed upon.

IV. Certification of Funds

- 4.1 It is expressly understood and agreed by the parties that none of the rights, duties, and obligations described in this MOU shall be binding on either party until all relevant statutory provisions of the Ohio Revised Code, including, but not limited to, O.R.C. Section 126.07, have been complied with, and until such time as all necessary funds are available or encumbered and, when required, such expenditure of funds is approved by the Controlling Board of the State of Ohio.

V. Transfer and Conditions

- 5.1 BWC shall transfer up to \$1,000,000.00 dollars ("transfer") to the DOC for the purpose of providing additional funding to the DOC's Firefighter I Training Grant program by which Firefighter I or Firefighter I Transition certification classes approved by the Department of Public Safety in accordance with section 4765.55 of the Revised Code are provided at no cost to selected students/volunteer firefighters, as defined by 146.01 of the Revised Code, attending the Ohio Fire Academy or other class providers approved by the State Fire Marshal. Transfer(s) may be made in whole or in part at mutually agreed upon dates. However, at least \$500,000.00 shall be transferred no later than December 15, 2014. The remaining funds as requested by the DOC shall be transferred no later than May 1, 2015.
- 5.2 Selected students shall be volunteer firefighters affiliated, as members, with fire departments that pay premiums to the Bureau of Worker's Compensation state insurance fund in accordance with Section 4123.35 of the Revised Code and are otherwise in compliance with the Bureau of Worker's Compensation regulations.
- 5.3 DOC and BWC shall work on establishing a process for verifying that the firefighters benefiting from this training are affiliated with fire departments that are in full compliance with BWC regulations and rules
- 5.4 DOC shall provide to BWC copies of class rosters upon completion of the class submitted to the DOC from the course providers indicating the name of the course provider, name and date of the training course, names of the students, designations of the students' affiliations with a fire department, and an indication as to each fire department's BWC compliance status as confirmed by BWC in accordance with section 5.3 of this agreement.
- 5.5 Upon the termination of fiscal year 2015, if the DOC has a remaining unencumbered balance of transferred funds, the remaining unencumbered balance of the transferred funds shall be transferred to the BWC from the DOC.

VI. Communications

- 6.1 BWC and DOC shall collaborate, when necessary, on announcements, responses to media, and other media related communications relating to the transfer and/or Firefighter I Training Grant Program. The points of contacts for communications are as follows:



- 8.2 Liability. Each party is responsible for its respective employees. Neither party to this Agreement shall be liable for any negligent or wrongful acts, either of commission or omission, chargeable to the other. In no event shall either party be liable to the other party for indirect consequential, incidental, special or punitive damage, or lost profit or wages.
- 8.3 Entire Agreement. This instrument constitutes the entire agreement of the parties on the subject matter of this MOU, and supersedes all prior agreements, understanding, or representations concerning the subject matter of this MOU. This MOU is subject to and controlled by applicable law. This MOU shall be executed in duplicate with each Agency retaining an original.
- 8.4 Amendment. This MOU may be amended in writing signed by all parties, and any such amendment shall be attached hereto, and incorporated as if fully written herein. Said amendment shall be effective upon the execution of the same by the parties.



**ADDENDUM FOR RENEWAL AND MODIFICATION
OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BY AND BETWEEN
THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION
AND
THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE**

This Addendum is a renewal and modification of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) previously agreed December 1, 2014 by and between the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation (BWC) and the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of State Fire Marshal (DOC).

BWC and DOC entered into an MOU on December 1, 2014 to memorialize an agreement to transfer funds from the BWC Safety and Hygiene fund to the DOC Firefighter I Training Grant Program by which Ohio first responders shall receive safety training.

Section III, 3.3, of the MOU allows the parties to renew the MOU on written agreement of the parties. DOC and BWC hereby renew the MOU for the 2016 Fiscal Year, beginning July 1, 2015 and ending June 30, 2016.

This renewal shall be effective upon full execution and shall expire on the earlier of June 30, 2016 or upon the final expenditure by DOC of funds encumbered in accordance with this MOU. Either party may suspend or terminate this MOU if the General Assembly fails to appropriate funds in accordance with Section IV. of this MOU or if either party fails to abide by the terms of this agreement.


Section III, 3.2, of such agreement allows the parties to modify the MOU by mutual written agreement by the parties.

Therefore, the MOU is modified as follows:

1. In section V., 5.1, the date of the last transfer is changed from May 1, 2015 to June 30, 2015 and the provision is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 5.1 BWC shall transfer up to \$1,000,000.00 dollars ("transfer") to the DOC for the purpose of providing additional funding to the DOC's Firefighter I Training Grant program by which Firefighter I or Firefighter I Transition certification classes approved by the Department of Public Safety in accordance with section 4765.55 of the Revised Code are provided at no cost to selected students/volunteer firefighters, as defined by 146.01 of the Revised Code, attending the Ohio Fire Academy or other class providers approved by the State Fire Marshal. Transfer(s) may be made in whole or in part at mutually agreed upon dates. However, at least \$500,000.00 shall be transferred no later than December 15, 2014. The remaining funds as requested by the DOC shall be transferred no later than June 30, 2015.

2. Section V., 5.3, is hereby stricken from the document as the process by which DOC and BWC establish a process for verifying firefighters benefiting from training are affiliated with fire departments that are in full compliance with BWC regulations and rules is contained in Section V., 5.4.
3. Section V., 5.4, is modified to strike reference to Section 5.3.
 - 5.4 DOC shall provide to BWC copies of class rosters upon completion of the class submitted to the DOC from the course providers indicating the name of the course provider, name and date of the training course, names of the students, designations of the students' affiliations with a fire department, and an indication as to each fire department's BWC compliance status.
4. Section V., 5.5, is modified to indicate that the remaining balance of funds may be distributed the following fiscal year in accordance with a renewal of the MOU and the provision is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 5.5 Upon the termination of fiscal year 2015, the remaining balance of the transferred funds shall be distributed in accordance with the terms of the MOU in the following fiscal year.
5. Upon the termination of fiscal year 2016, if the MOU is not further renewed and if the DOC has a remaining unencumbered balance of transferred funds, the remaining unencumbered balance of the transferred funds shall be transferred to the BWC within sixty (60) days of the end of the fiscal year.
6. All other terms of the original MOU shall remain in effect.

This renewal shall be effective upon full execution and shall expire on the earlier of June 30, 2017 or upon the final expenditure by DOC of funds encumbered in accordance with this MOU. Either party may suspend or terminate this MOU if the General Assembly fails to appropriate funds in accordance with Section IV of the MOU or if either party fails to abide by the terms of the agreement.

Section III, 3.2, of such agreement allows the parties to modify the MOU by mutual written agreement by the parties.

Therefore, the MOU is modified as follows:

1. Section V., 5.1, is hereby stricken from the document and replaced with the following language:
 - 5.1 On December 11, 2014, BWC transferred \$500,000.00 dollars ("transfer") to the DOC for the purpose of providing additional funding to the DOC's Firefighter I Training Grant program by which Firefighter I or Firefighter I Transition certification classes approved by the Department of Public Safety in accordance with section 4765.55 of the Revised Code are provided at no cost to selected students/volunteer firefighters, as defined by 146.01 of the Revised Code, attending the Ohio Fire Academy or other class providers

approved by the State Fire Marshal. A second transfer of \$500,000.00 was made to the State Fire Marshal on June 11, 2015.

- 2. Section V., 5.5, is modified to indicate that the remaining balance of funds may be distributed the following fiscal year in accordance with a renewal of the MOU and the provision is hereby amended to read as follows:


- 5.5 Upon the termination of fiscal year 2016, the remaining balance of the transferred funds shall be distributed in accordance with the terms of the MOU in the following fiscal year.

- 3. With respect to language added to the agreement in the June 15, 2015 renewal, #5 is modified to indicate the next fiscal year as follows:

- 5. Upon the termination of fiscal year 2017, if the MOU is not further renewed and if the DOC has a remaining unencumbered balance of transferred funds, the remaining unencumbered balance of the transferred funds shall be transferred to the BWC within sixty (60) days of the end of the fiscal year.

- 4. All other terms of the original MOU and June 15, 2015 renewal shall remain in effect.
