OHIO INSPECTOR GENERAL FINDS STATE EMPLOYEES CONFUSED BY CONFLICTING PROCEDURES

Columbus, Ohio, July 18, 2013

The inspector general has issued reports of investigation today finding two Ohio Department of Job and Family Services employees followed another state agency's fraud -reporting procedures, which was in conflict with the internal fraud-reporting policies of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services.

While the employees' actions caused a violation of confidential personal information handling policy, there was no evidence found to suggest the confidential personal information was at risk of being misused, nor did evidence indicate either employee acted maliciously, or for any personal benefit.
