OHIO INSPECTOR GENERAL INVESTIGATES WRONGFUL ACCESS OF CONFIDENTIAL PERSONAL INFORMATION AT THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION
Columbus, Ohio, April 16, 2014

The Ohio Inspector General has issued a report of investigation today finding an Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation employee wrongfully accessed the claim files and confidential personal information of a relative.

The inspector general was notified by the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation after a supervisory employee reported a claims service specialist in the Lima service office may have improperly accessed the records.

The report of investigation will be provided to the prosecuting attorneys for Allen County, and the City of Lima, for further consideration.
