OHIO INSPECTOR GENERAL FINDS COMPLAINT AGAINST OHIO DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION
WITHOUT MERIT

Columbus, Ohio, April 1, 2015

The inspector general has issued a report of investigation today which reviewed the veracity of a complaint alleging officials at the Ohio Department of Education wrongfully provided information during an ongoing investigation. The complainant purported the information was used against him in a child custody dispute with his former wife.

Interviews conducted with several witnesses failed to support the basis for the allegation, and confirmed that individuals, not connected to or employed by the Ohio Department of Education, were previously aware of, and had provided the information used in the custody dispute.
