OHIO INSPECTOR GENERAL DETERMINES CONFIDENTIAL PERSONAL INFORMATION
WRONGFULLY ACCESSED AT THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION
Columbus, Ohio, August 18, 2015

The Ohio Inspector General has issued a report of investigation today involving the wrongful access of confidential personal information by an Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation medical exam scheduler in the Cincinnati Service Office.

The inspector general was notified by administrators at the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation after an employee reported concerns about comments made by a medical exam scheduler. The investigation found the exam scheduler, Nina Parm, violated agency policies by not taking proper action after accessing a relative's claim files. The investigation also found when Parm finally reported the mistake, a bureau of workers' compensation information specialist also violated policy by failing to follow the direction of superiors and immediately reassign the injured worker's claim for special handling.

The report of investigation will be provided to the Hamilton County Prosecuting Attorney for further consideration.
